CPS will be supporting girls volleyball, boys soccer, and boys and girls cross country for fall sports this year. CPS will not be offering flag football. CPS will continue the no cut no tryout policy, meaning everyone can join the team of their choice.

Practice and Game Schedule: All practices start the week of September 11th.

Soccer and Volleyball- (both teams have games on the same dates)

Games are held on Saturdays at a local high school or park district, the location and exact schedule is still TBD. The games will start on October 7th and go through November 11th. A single game championship will be held on November 18th, for the 7/8th teams only, should any of our teams finish first or second at the end of the regular season. There are **no playoffs for 5/6th teams.**
